AWWA Features Scott Candler Water Plant

Decatur, GA — Scott Candler Water Treatment Facility has been chosen by The American Water Works Association (AWWA) as one of the feature attractions during its 2008 Conference. The conference will be held at the Georgia World Congress Center on June 8-12, 2008.

Water experts from around the world will tour the Scott Candler Water Treatment Facility and will only be available to registered conference attendees.

The Scott Candler Water Treatment facility is one of the largest fully automated and computerized water treatment plants in the Southeast. The plant officially opened in September 2007 and was designed to use advanced treatment technologies to achieve current and future regulatory requirements, and meet high standards for reliability and risk based redundancy for DeKalb County and its citizens.

The new plant includes an administration building with a laboratory, training facilities, and an operator control center that controls the plant through a new state-of-the-art supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) system.
