

One of the DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management's (DWM) highest priorities is to prevent and minimize wastewater overflows. In an effort to do this, the DWM routinely performs sanitary sewer line easement clearings throughout the county. Easement clearing projects consist of tree cutting and removal with brush and vegetation clearing. The objective of clearing projects is to ensure safe access for inspecting, rehabilitating, maintaining, and repairing the existing sanitary sewer system.

In the upcoming weeks, Casey Tree Experts crews will be in your area to provide sewer easement vegetation maintenance for DeKalb County Department of Watershed Management. Casey Tree Experts will be working on the easements in the area of Land Lot 192 on the following easements: Castleway Drive, Deborah Drive, Castleway Lane, Riviera Court, Breckenridge Drive, Wendland Drive, and Aspen Drive. Crews will also be working in the area of Land Lot 193 on the following easements: Mercedes Drive, North Akin Drive, Grand Prix Drive, Grand Prix Court, and Starfire Drive. **This work will be conducted in the following subdivisions: Three Oaks, Breckenridge, Lavista Harbor, Oak Grove Acres, and Glen Oaks.**

This project will last for approximately two to three weeks and will begin on Wednesday, October 6-22, 2010. Residents that will be affected directly can visit the DWM website at www.dekalbwatershed.com under "Projects" to view an aerial map of this area.
