

Scott Boulevard-Peavine Creek Watershed Improvement Project
Weekly Update Number 10
December 17, 2007-January 15, 2008

Portland Utilities completed all pipe bursting for the Scott Boulevard-Peavine Creek Watershed Improvement Project as of the week of December 24th. To date, the contractor continues with post-bursting clean up including seeding, sodding, landscaping and paving. All activity is expected to be complete, and equipment removed, by Friday, January 25th.

The contractor rehabilitated a total of 2,035 linear feet of pipe over the course of the three month project, ensuring the long-term safety, reliability and environmental protection of DeKalb County's water and sewer system.
